Everyone seemed to enjoy the convention. We had 171 pre-registrations this year with 26 of those people pre-registering on line. We had 209 people registering at the convention, 22 newcomer packets and six day passes. This was a total of 408 registrations with a total of 3233 years and five months clean. That averages out to 7 years, 11 months per person.

Sixty-three cities from Colorado were represented and 49 people from out-of-state. We had a record year with banquet sales at 220 people. Breakfast was 175 people and 72 people paid for the comedian without buying the banquet. There was \$960.00 donated for the newcomer and \$685.00 donated for coffee.

Our last meeting with subcommittee's will be November 18, 2000, at 10:00 a.m. at 5648 W. Center. We are still in the process of closing out the books and are waiting for a bill from the hotel. I will give you a final report at the January CRSC. I also hope to have suggested guideline changes done by the January CRSC.
