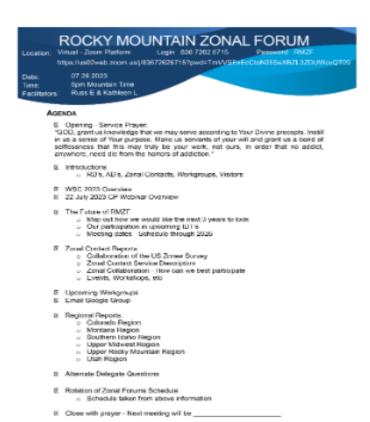

The purpose of the Collaboration of US Zones is to:

Some of the results from the Conference Agenda Report (CAR) and Conference Approval Track (CAT) included:

Moving the WSC to a 3yr cycle through 2029 with a virtual interim WSC mid-cycle. Also providing the CAR 30 days earlier giving 180 days for review.

Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust (FIPT) - Adding the Zonal Delegates as the Settlors and Trustors of the FIPT

Initiate gender-neutral language: Direct the World Board to create a project plan for the next WSC to initiate the process for the Fellowship to approve adding "gender" to "What is the NA Program?" to read: "Anyone may join us regardless of age, race, gender, sexual identity, creed, religion or lack of religion."

To direct the World Board to create a project plan for consideration at the next WSC to investigate changes and/or additional wording to NA literature from gender specific language to gender neutral and inclusive language. Intent: This motion will give the conference and the Fellowship the ability to meaningfully discuss changes to our literature to be more inclusive of all our members. Carries with Strong Support Revise A Vision for NA Service, changing the phrase "his or her own language and culture" to the phrase "their own language and culture." A Vision for NA Service will be revised in future printings, including in Fellowship-approved recovery literature. Create a project plan to update the Hospitals and Institutions Handbook and remove outdated terms and references. Acknowledge that an NA meeting that meets regularly in person or virtually can choose to be an NA group if they meet the criteria described in The Group Booklet, including the six points for an NA group, and are consistent with NA philosophy as expressed in our Traditions.

As a result of the COVID pandemic, to suspend the World Convention of NA (WCNA) rotation policy after 2024, to allow the World Board to determine what is possible and practical moving forward and then seek approval from conference participants. Given the disruption in the rotation of WSC and WCNA that has already occurred, the increases in event costs, and the other changes brought about by the pandemic, to allow an evaluation by the World Board and approval by conference participants for what is possible and practical in the future.

To amend the CRCNA and CRSC guidelines as follows: green is existing text, highlights are changes.

PROPOSED CRCNA GUIDELINE CHANGES

1) Add the following tasks:

Pg 5, heading: JOB DESCRIPTION FOR CRCNA ADMINISTRATIVE VICE CHAIR

TASKS:

- Assemble and facilitate a small group of addicts to move, set up, and monitor the Archive display at CRCNA a minimum of every 5 years.
- Assist the Regional Vice Chair in updating the instructions as to space requirements, packing and storage if a needed change is discovered during CRCNA display.
- 2) Pg 6, bullet 2:
 - Pays the storage shed bills each year.

POPOSED CRSC GUIDELINE CHANGES

1) Add the following task to Regional vice chair:

Pg 8, Article 5, Section B:

- Hold the keys for the Archive storage shed.
- Meets at the unit to check the material and key in and out to CRCNA or any group that has arranged to display the Archive material.
- Update the Archive instructions as to space requirements, inventory, packing and storage as needed.
 Ensure the instructions are visible to anyone who enters the storage area.
- Works with CRCNA Subcommittee chairs to ensure at least a T-shirt, cup, and registration packet from current year's CRCNA is added to the storage area and inventory.

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Pg 15, Article 9, section B, bullet 2

The PO Box and two storage sheds will be an automatic disbursement when it occurs. All CRSCNA check disbursements should be made to organizations, businesses, etc. rather than to an individual addict

wherever practical and approved by the CRSCNA. No reimbursements will be made without a receipt and/or CRSCNA approval

3) Pg 24, Article 11, section B, bullets 2 and 3
