This month I attended the Merchandise Sub Committee meeting. Merchandise chose a jewelry vendor and spoke about preconvention t-shirt sales and convention merchandise sold to date.

I picked up the completed quilt from Marcia on 6/24/21. It is a little bit smaller than a twin size bed. It did turn out nice. Please continue to announce that we need CRCNA t-shirts for the 2022 quilt.

I confirmed with Lucy from Burning Queens for the Poker Tournament to be held on Friday night.

The June event at Collyer Neighborhood Park was a success. We made \$71.00 in the 7th Tradition and sold \$34.00 in raffle tickets. Mark completed the taxes for sales at the event to the City of Longmont in the amount of \$4.00. We lost \$10.00 total but sold registrations and preconvention t-shirts. It was a good time.

Our next event is being planned for Saturday August 21, 2021. Kathleen has graciously agreed to put this one together with our help. I have spoken to the Activity Chairs from Off the Wall, Mile High, and the Pikes Peak areas to get the events in the planning stages. I have been working with Sarah L, Mile High Activities Chair in trying to get a venue for the Aug 21 event to no avail yet.

Currently our open subcommittee chair positions are Fundraising and Entertainment. Please let the fellowship know we need a Vice Chair and a Vice Treasurer. The next regional meeting will be 07/18/2021, virtually via zoom at 10:00AM.

Treasure Written Report:

CRCNA XXXV Treasure Report Mark M. 07/10/2021

Our balance from last CRCNA meeting was \$11,621.35. Income from PayPal was \$6,113.00. Income from Square was \$45.00. Income from the Picnic was \$105.00 in Merchandise and \$107.00 F&E. Cash returned was \$200.00. Apparently, Joann sold a Pre-Convention T for \$15.00 plus \$6.00 shipping. More on that later. Expenses were \$194.78 PayPal charges. Cash out for change was

\$200.00. Square charged \$1.37. We paid Top Shelf \$469.68 for t shirts. We also paid \$4.00 sales tax to the City of Longmont and a \$2.00 bank charge. This brings our available balance to \$17,334.52.

Since the cost for putting on the Picnic was \$105.00 that means we made \$2.00 or \$107.00 if we look at it as cash taken in at the event. Since we took in \$1,935.56 in online registration and merchandise that total would be \$1937.56 or \$2042.56.

The other thing I noticed was that whoever sold the 3 Pre-convention t shirts on Square also deposited the amount into the bank account. I am not sure that I am ok with that. That is my job as I see it, but I don't know if that is the proper stance I should take.

Lastly, when Joann sold the Pre-convention T she also charged shipping but it did not show up in the bank account so I did not record it. To do so I would need a receipt for that amount.

We are starting to Rock and Roll now so let's get with the program people.

Good Morning Family! Only 4 months away from an AMAZING convention!!!

Happy to report a lot of progress in the last month. Registration numbers continue to promise a successful convention this year. The Speaker Meeting in Longmont was a smashing success. Thank you, Kathleen. The registration subcommittee did a fantastic job showing up, interacting, and helping members get registered online. Almost every single non-registered member at that event was registered by the end of the event due to personalized attention by the registration subcommittee. Way to go! Love the shirts, Karl! Also, a great addition to this year.

With a budget of \$7,665 as follows:

\$2,325 Badges/Lanyards

\$5,175 Registration Packets

\$165 Admin Supplies

\$7,665

We have come up with a rough estimate at this time of \$5,390 for registration.

"Swag bag" supplies. This includes the following:

Masks \$2.38 x 1000 = \$2,380

Pens \$.78 x 1000 = \$780

Magnets $$1.31 \times 1000 = $1,310$

Stickers $$.92 \times 1000 = 920

\$5,390

We currently have 353 bags inventoried from past years that we are planning to upcycle as discussed before. With a budget of \$2,275 left in our budget we will have to spend some on bags. I will have that info at the next meeting.

Due to travel, the subcommittee meeting has been rescheduled to 7/17/21 at 11 am. We will vote on & finalize items for swag bags & discuss attendance & manning events, etc.
