- FACILITIES BEING SERVED BY PPAH&I:
  1. CRIMINAL JUSTICE CENTER (CJC) THE MEN'S MEETING TAKES PLACE ONE TIME PER MONTH AND THE WOMEN'S MEETING TAKES PLACE TWICE A MONTH. WE ARE CURRENTLY IN NEED OF MORE ADDICTS, ESPECIALLY MEN, T SERVE ON THESE PANELS. HOWEVER, PART OF THE PROBLEM IS THAT THE REQUIREMENTS TO ATTEND CJC ARE STRICTER THAN ANY OTHER OF OUR FACILITIES. IT REQUIRES 1 YEAR CLEAN AND 3 YEARS OFF PAPER. MOST CLIENTS ARE THERE FROM A FEW MONTHS TO A COUPLE OF YEARS.

  - BUDETARY NEEDS:

WE CURRENTLY RECEIVE \$150 ALLOTMENT FROM OUR ASC MONTHLY. ALL FUNDS GO TO PURCHASE LITERATURE THAT IS DISTRIBUTED AMONG ALL THE FACILITIES.

- IDEAS AND PROJECTS

AFTER CRCNA WE HELD AN H&I, PI AND PHONELINE LEARNING DAYS. UNFORTUNATELY, WE HAD VERY LITTLE SUPPORT FROM BOTH OUR AREA AND FORM THE REGION, BUT WE DO FEEL THAT FOR THOSE WHO DID ATTEND, IT WAS WORTH THE EFFORT. WE DID A MOCK PANEL PRESENTATION THAT ALLOWED FOR PARTICIPATION FORM EVERYONE. WE ASK SOME OF THE MORE TRICKY QUESTIONS THAT CAN BE PUT TO A PANEL AND THEN DISCUSSED THE REPOSSES. AT PRIOR LEARNING DAYS WE PRODUCED A PLAY THAT SHOWED HOW ALL THE SUBCOMMITTEES WORK TOGETHER TO GET THE ADDICT TO A MEETING. WE ARE ALSO WORKING ON PUTTING TOGETHER A GAME SHOW FOR OUR NEXT LEARNING DAYS. WE WOULD REALLY LIKE TO GET MORE AREAS TO PARTICIPATE.
