Somehow this translated into the bill being skipped for one month in the confusion. Our literature subcommittee is consistently short of Basic Texts and many groups receive portions of their literature on "back order". We are humbly asking for financial help from the region (see motion) with these two matters.

On a more positive note, we have a new Webmaster as well as a new Activities Chair. The only Area level positions that need to be filled are Vice-Chair and Secretary. Meeting attendance is consistently good for all nights with the exception of Monday night. The Monday night meeting, which is at 7:00 p.m. at Boulder One on Bluff Street, has only one trusted servant and that one is only temporary. The meeting is in despite need of trusted servants and better attendance. This meeting is the oldest Narcotics Anonymous meeting in the State of Colorado, which is an excellent reason why addicts from other areas might want to come to the meeting to support it.

Our PI subcommittee recently did a mailing to some of the institutions in Boulder County and the H&I subcommittee is working on starting some NA meetings in several different facilities.
