The impromptu training session went well considering it was done on the spur of the moment. Overall it was agreed that this will have advantages in more than one way. We will be able to train recovering addicts to be of service with three different subcommittees by attending just one training session. Also one person can train all three of the different subcommittees versus having three separate trainers. The All-in-One training is being developed into a PowerPoint presentation for ease of facilitating the training seminar. The Area also is in the process of purchasing a computer projector for these training seminars and also for use in Public Information presentations.
2. Social Media Portal for the Area, i.e. a Facebook Page for the Mile High Area and a Twitter Account for the Mile High Area. As can be expected this topic made for quite a bit of discussion, mostly due to concerns about privacy and anonymity. It was discussed that the Area would more than likely start with a Facebook Page first and not a Twitter account. Before even implementing a Facebook Page an Ad-hoc committee was formed to research and assemble some guidelines.


